We get 10 minutes in the ring for our demonstration. The demo break down:

1 Minute: Group Intro

We will come out as a group doing a “Drill Team” like entrance. Your horse must be able to ride with horses on its side, in front and behind. Horses will need to handle the commotion from the crowd and grounds people setting up the arena.

2 Minutes: Intro Level

There will be two or three riders chosen for the Intro Level group. These riders must be able to show off Intro-Training level dressage movements, and be able to jump 18-24”. When the three riders are chosen it is up to them to discuss and come up with how they want to show off their level with the 2 minutes.

2 Minutes: Intermediate Level

There will be two or three riders chosen for the Intermediate Level group. These riders must be able to show off First-Third level dressage movements, and be able to jump 2’6”-3’3”. When the three riders are chosen it is up to them to discuss and come up with how they want to show off their level with the 2 minutes.

2 Minutes: Advanced Dressage Rider

There will be one rider chosen for this position unless a Pas De Deux applies together. They must successfully perform fourth level and higher dressage movements.

2 Minutes: Advanced Jumper

There will be one or two riders chosen for this position. They must successfully jump higher than 3’6” several times.

1 Minute: Group Outro

We will all group back up and do a group outro. This will be similar to the intro so again, horses need to be ok being in a group while things are going on around them.

Riders **MUST** attend **ALL** practices. This is crucial as the horses need to become familiar with each other and the routine needs to become clean and organized and that can’t be done with horses missing. Practices will be held at Lindinhof Equine Sports Zentrum in Oregon in February and March. Dates will be announced ASAP. There will also be phone meetings and a Facebook group chat for planning purposes. We will have alternate riders as well in case something comes up that a chosen rider(s) is unable to make a practice. All riders will pay a \$50 stall fee and must be prepared with show attire and tack for the demo.
